Top US Environmental Leader in Brisbane for the World Clean Air Congress

Dr Alan Lloyd, President of the International Council on Clean Transportation is in Brisbane this week as keynote speaker at the 14th World Clean Air Congress. Dr Lloyd is also ex-Chairman of the influential and prestigious California Air Resources Board, ex-Secretary of the California EPA, and has been a key contributor to California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's environmental initiatives.

Dr Lloyd has an extensive background in dealing with California's air pollution problems, especially those from vehicle emissions. He has been instrumental in formulating the policies that now have California in the forefront of measures to produce cleaner vehicles. Apart from the impact of vehicle emissions on degrading air quality in cities, he is now also concerned about the effects of transportation emissions on global climate change.

"I am very pleased to be coming to Brisbane, which shares a lot of similarities with California – we have much to learn from each other" said Dr Lloyd. "We are both in warm climates, with high growth rates, and a lot of issues with air pollution emissions from vehicles." "I think Australia has a very important role to play in keeping our air clean and reducing greenhouse gas emissions."

Dr Lloyd will be addressing the Congress delegates at the Brisbane Convention Centre on Monday 10th September at 10.50am.
